

2018 Southeastern Regional Junior Hereford Show Rules

1. Exhibitors must be seven years old and not yet 22 years old by January 1, 2018, and a member of the NJHA and/or their respective State Association.
2. All animals must be registered in the American Hereford Association.
3. Each entry must be owned by the junior exhibitor and in his/her recorded ownership by June 1, 2018. Entries may be co-owned by siblings, provided each is an individual NJHA member. No farm or family names allowed.
4. Entry fees are \$30 per head, with an additional \$10 per each Bred and Owned heifer entry. Entry fees must accompany the entry form, or entry cannot be accepted. All animals must be registered prior to entry deadline date. No late transfers will be accepted. Entries with "pending" listed as the registration number will not be accepted. Entry fees are not refundable.
5. All entries must be processed by 5:00 p.m. June 15, 2018. No cattle can be stalled prior to Thursday, June 14, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. Cattle are released following the show, and must be out of the barn by noon, June 17, 2018.
6. Original registration certificates must be present at check-in. All animals will have tattoos checked. Tattoos that are missing, illegible, altered, incorrect, and any other way disagree with the official AHA records will be a justifiable cause for disqualification.
7. Entries must meet Georgia health regulations. All animals must have an official health certificate.
8. Exhibitors must show their own animals, unless he/she has two animals in the same class, or has official approval from the show management.
9. No one may assist exhibitor in the show ring. Exhibitor must wear entry numbers on chest and back.
10. Exhibitor must follow AHA rules as stated in the official "Rules, Regulations, and Bylaws" of the AHA.
11. Cash awards will depend on the number of entries in the show.
12. If all requirements aren't met, the show management reserves the right to disqualify any entry.
13. All persons making entries in the show shall agree to abide by all the rules and regulations as outlined and will not hold the AHA, the Georgia Hereford Association, or the Georgia Junior Hereford Association and organizers responsible for accident, loss, or injury to any person, animal, or article.
14. 2018 SE Regional theme T-shirts are required to be worn by exhibitors when exhibiting.
15. No farm signs may be displayed at the stalls. Family signs may be displayed if junior exhibitor's names are included on the sign.

Showmanship:

1. Bulls are not allowed in showmanship classes.
2. Showmanship will be divided into 4 divisions: PeeWee (Ages 7-9 as of Jan 1, 2018), Junior (Ages 10 -13 as of Jan 1, 2018), Intermediate (Ages 14 – 17 as of Jan 1, 2018), and Senior (Ages 18 – 21 as of Jan 1, 2018).
3. AHA Showmanship rules will apply.
4. An "Ultra PeeWee" Showmanship class will be held for youth under the official showing age of 7. Please pre-register.

Bedding and supplies:

Stall bedding will be provided.
Wheat straw may be available to purchase for tie-out bedding. Show supplies will be available on site. Call 912-682-8670 for availability of straw.

NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE BARN OR ARENA!**Heifer Rules:**

1. Heifer classes will include:
Spring & Junior Calf – calved on or after 1/1/18
Senior Calf – calved 08/01/17 to 12/31/17
Late Summer Yearling – calved 06/16/17 to 07/31/17
Early Summer Yearling – calved 05/01/17 to 06/15/17
Spring Yearling – calved 03/01/17 to 04/30/17
Junior Yearling – calved 01/01/17 to 02/28/17
Senior Yearling – calved 08/01/16 to 12/31/16
2. Owned and Bred-and-Owned Show will show concurrently.
3. For eligibility in the Bred & Owned Show, exhibitor must have owned the entry's dam at the time of conception and must be listed as the breeder on the registration certificate.
4. Horned and Polled Heifers will show together.
5. Classes will be divided according to the number of entries.

Cow/Calf Rules:

1. The cow must be owned by the junior exhibitor at the time of the calf's conception. The calf must be her natural calf, and no older than 270 days on show day, and be bred by the junior exhibitor.
2. The classes will be divided by the cow's age.

3. Entry fee for the pair is \$30. Calves entered as individuals must pay the additional entry fee.

Bull Rules:

1. Bulls must be bred-and-owned to be eligible for the Bull Show. The exhibitor must have owned the entry's dam at the time of conception, and must be listed as the breeder on the registration certificate.
2. Bulls calved after 01/01/16 are eligible. Horned and Polled bulls will show together.
3. All bulls calved before 01/01/18 must be shown with a nose lead.
4. Classes will be divided according to number of entries.

Steer Rules:

1. The steer must be purebred and owned by the junior exhibitor by June 1, 2018. AHA Steer Certificates will be required for the SE Regional.
4. The classes will be divided by "Prospect Steers" and "Finished Steers" and presented by weight.

Tie area:

Each state will be assigned a tie area for their entries. Animals will be tied as a state group. An area will be assigned each state for tack, coolers, chairs, etc. Assigned spaces will be strictly enforced. Please work together as a state group to respect the space assignments.

Georgia National Fairground Rules:

1. Blocking Chutes must not be in the main aisle of the barn.
2. No butt fans
3. No dogs in the barn, or in the arena.

Cattle may be stalled in the barn at 8:00 a.m. Thursday, June 14, 2018. Cattle must be off the fairgrounds by Noon, Sunday, June 17, 2018.
