

Georgia Hereford Field Day and Contests

This year's Georgia Hereford Field Day will be hosted by **McDonald Farms, Charles and Alexis Woodward - on June 13th**. Entry forms are included in your May GHA Newsletter, on the Georgia Hereford Association website – www.georgiahereford.com - or call (478) 494-6693 if you need more information. If you have never attended, this is a great opportunity to visit new parts of our State, and to meet other Hereford exhibitors. Field Day offers lots of things for juniors to compete in: a junior show, photo contest, poster contest, a beef quiz, judging contest, and a speech contest. Following is a brief description of each event:

Junior Heifer and Bull Show

This year your September 1, 2018 and younger heifers are eligible for Field Day, as well as Cow-Calf pairs, Bred-and Owned Bulls, and Steers. All entries must be eligible for the Jr. National Expo. The show will also include the regular Showmanship classes, and the exciting Ultra-PeeWee Showmanship! Be sure and send in the entry form with your entries by June 1st.

Photo Contest

Bring your favorite Polled Hereford photo to Field Day. It should be 5x7 or 8x10, and can be matted. Please do not frame them. To enter the contest at the Junior National, you must submit your photo via email. See the Junior page on the AHA website at www.hereford.org. Send your entry to the AHA Junior Activities Dept. by June 1st. See the AHA website for categories. Be sure and make a copy to enter at Field Day!! Remember, only 2 entries per junior at Field Day.

Poster Contest

The theme of this year's poster contest is "Banners in the Bluegrass!!" Your poster must include the Event - Junior National Hereford Expo, Date – July 11– July 18, 2020, Actual Location - which is Louisville, Kentucky, and Theme of the 2020 Junior National Hereford Expo on a poster of at least 14"x22" and no bigger than 22"x28".

You can enter your poster at Field Day, and take or send it on to the Jr. National after that.

Illustrated Speech

The topic for this year's speech contest must be related to the Beef Industry, and must include a minimum of one illustration or visual aid. There are 3 Divisions: Junior speeches, for ages 10-13, and Intermediate speeches, for ages 14-17 are 3 to 5 minutes long. Senior speeches, for ages 18-21, are 6 to 8 minutes long. The Division winners will be eligible to compete at the Jr. National. PeeWees, ages 7-9, are also encouraged to participate.

Beef Quiz

The Beef Quiz is a way to test your knowledge of Herefords and the cattle industry. We also use it to pick our Beef Bowl Teams for Junior National.
