

Georgia Poll-ette/Hereford Women Scholarship Rules

2014

I. OBJECTIVE

To assist those selected young people in the furthering and advancing of his or her education in the various fields of Agriculture.

II. ELIGIBILITY

A. Qualified resident of the State of Georgia

B. High School Graduate

C. Applicant is to be recommended either by their County Agent, Club Advisor, 4-H or FFA Advisor, or their High School Principal.

D. Applicant must have 3 recommendations, one of which must be from one of the persons listed in C above.

E. Applicant must be a member of the Georgia Junior Hereford Association.

III. SELECTION

A. Scholarship recipient shall be selected from those qualified persons recommended by the Scholarship Committee.

B. Final selection shall be made by:

1. Scholarship Committee members.

2. President of the Georgia Poll-ettes

C. The Scholarship Committee will interview the applicant before final selection is made.

D. The applicant's interest and participation in Herefords will be taken into consideration.

IV. SCOPE

A. The amount to be awarded in each Scholarship shall be a fixed sum of \$1,000.00.

B. The Scholarship designated and so awarded may be used by the recipient for tuition, books, or other expenses directly related to his or her education in Agriculture or in subjects in related fields in any Junior or Senior College, or University so approved by the Scholarship Committee.

C. The need for financial assistance in the educational progress of each applicant shall be considered in the selection.

V. CONTROL

A. The scholarship will be paid to the recipient provided he or she has been accepted by an accredited College or University approved by the Scholarship Committee.

B. The recipient will be eligible to apply for the scholarship in future years provided grades are acceptable, standards are maintained and availability of funds.

VI. PRESENTATION

It shall be the goal of the Georgia Poll-ettes to present the Scholarship Award at the Georgia Hereford Association Field Day, which is held each year in June.
